Last Day - Thursday June 24th

Dismissal 10:32

Our final day with students this year is June 24th. **Dismissal will be at 10:32 a.m. so please make arrangements for your children to be picked up early or to arrive home early**. Report cards also go home on this day.

September Start Times

Our first day of school in September will be Tuesday, September 7th. We start at 8:30 a.m. and have dismissal at 11:30 a.m. that day. Students should bring a snack for recess on this day. Our first full day for grade one to five will be Wednesday, September 8th. **We start at 8:30 a.m. and go to 2:34 p.m.** Students should bring a snack and a full lunch for this day and from here on. Kindergarten students will be on their own schedule for the first few days and a letter with a link to the schedule specifically for kindergarten students was sent out prior to the summer break.

Nut Aware for start of September 2021 school year

As of September, we will have two students who are very allergic to **any nut products** (this includes peanuts, pine nuts, etc.). In the event of the students making contact with any of these products, they would go into anaphylaxis, a sudden and severe allergic reaction, which can be fatal, and requires immediate medical attention.

For next year, we are continuing to ask parents to be aware and respectful of this and please do not bring items to school in student lunches, classroom celebrations, treats, bake sales, etc. that contain or may contain nuts.

We are needing this to be school wide. The reason for a school wide policy is due to our school being very small, students sharing equipment regularly (sports equipment, musical instruments, computers, art supplies, etc.) and students working routinely in the same spaces or in the same classrooms. This results in many opportunities for other students from different classes having contact.

Staff will be trained on the medical procedures and be aware of the safety plan that will be followed if the student goes into anaphylaxis. All students and staff will be encouraged to have regular hand washing.

Our school will continue be "Nut Aware" which is a common practice in many schools in our district. If you have any questions, please speak with Mr. Overgaard.

At North Canoe, we do not require parents to purchase school supplies for their children at the beginning of the year. By charging a \$35 fee instead, teachers are able to purchase what is needed for students, which reduces waste and ensures value. Like most schools in our District, we also ask parents to pay an annual \$20 activity fee per student to assist with funding the performing arts (cultural performances by professional groups) and other

activities throughout the year. The total fee cost is \$55 per student. If paying some or all of the fees is a financial hardship, please contact Mr. Overgaard. We very much appreciate your support and cooperation with this.
